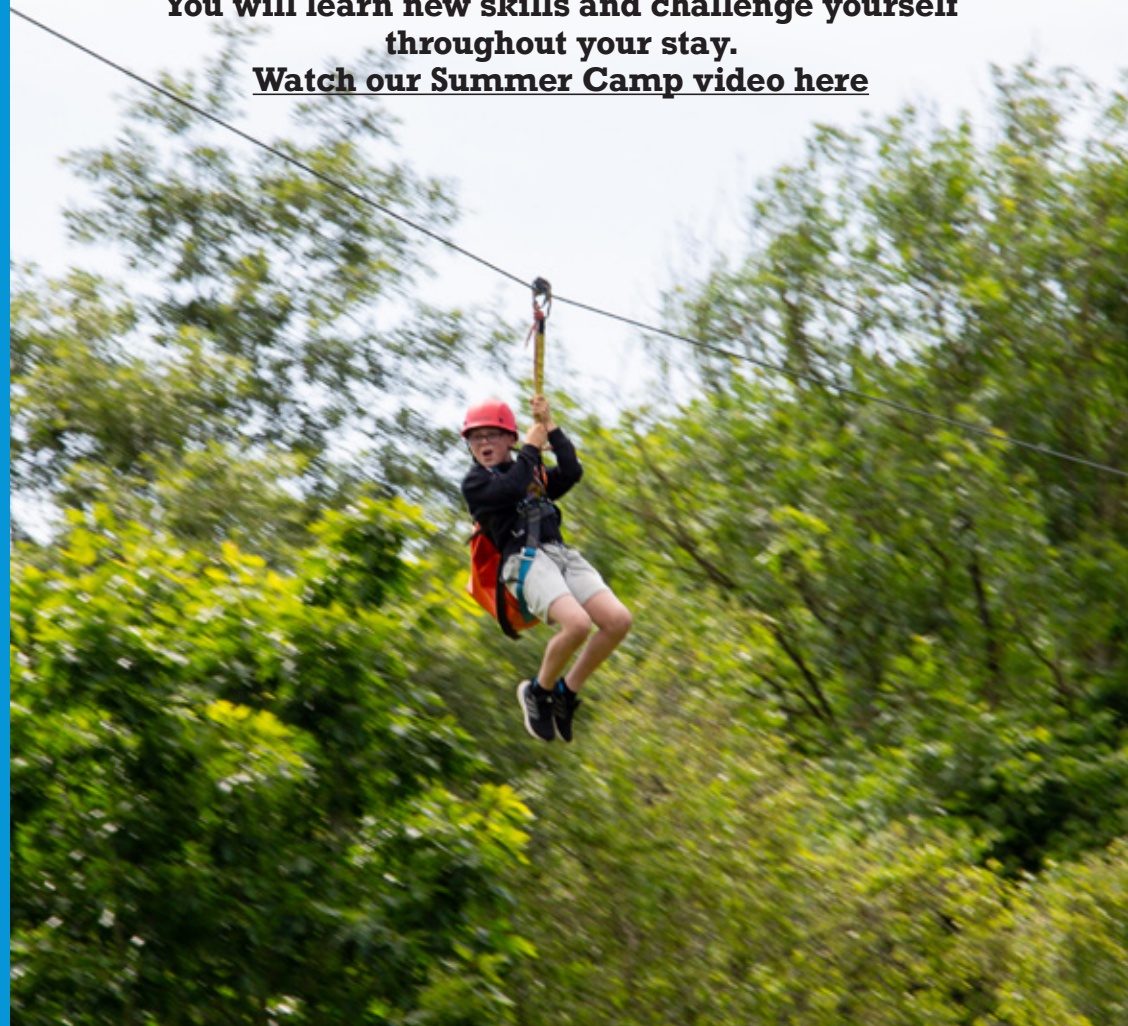

Summer Camps

We only have 72 places each week on our residential summer camps for 8–15 yrs olds. They run from Sunday afternoon till Saturday afternoon and you can stay for one or two weeks. You will be grouped according to your age. Activities are chosen specifically for your age group, keeping you entertained throughout the week, from pizza making, tunnelling, water slide to the 24-hour challenge, there really is so much to do.

Instructors

There are two Instructors (one female and one male) who stay with your group throughout the week. They are good fun, encouraging, kind and have a great sense of humour. Because you are with them for the whole week they really get to know you, help you overcome any fears and make sure that you have a fantastic week.

Food

Our Activity centre is like no other. All our food is home cooked, we cater for special diets and most of our vegetables are organically grown in our gardens. Each Friday to finish off the week we have a themed banquet which is delicious.

Bedrooms

The rooms are cosy with bunk beds, most of them have ensuite bathrooms, from 4–12 in a room, sharing with kids of your own age. Your room might even win the tidiest bedroom competition!

What about my phone?

Complete digital detox! No phone, no iPhone, no iPad, nothing electronic. Back to basics, making friends face to face, having fun with real people, actually talking and laughing together will build firm friendships, possibly for the rest of your life. Trust us you will have a blast!



24hr Challenge

The Otters are the oldest group and traditionally go on a 24-hour challenge for a day and a night. In previous years, they have learnt how to map read, hiked to camp, learnt about bush craft, abseiled and paddle boarded. Wait and see what we have in store for 2026! We take bookings online.

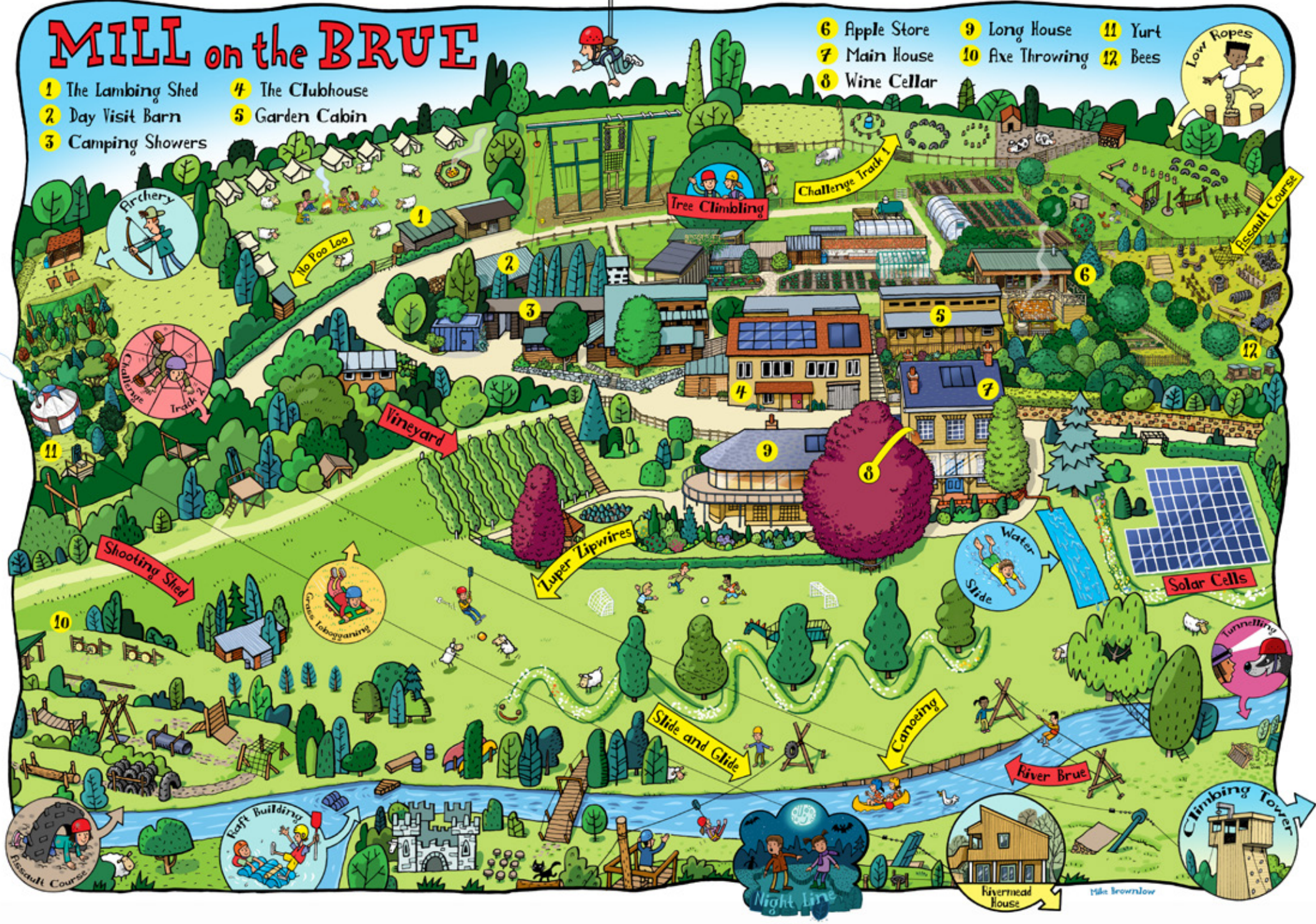
